## WHAT TO DO NEXT:

Please meet the instructor at 12 noon on the first day of class (**please notice that the first day of class has been changed from January 13 to January 20, 2018**). The Bath House Cultural Center is located at 521 E. Lawther Drive, Dallas, Texas 75218. The dates of the program are **January 20-April 21, 2018**. Your first meeting with the instructor will be in the art gallery area of the Bath House Cultural Center. There, you will be given a brief orientation of the program and will be asked to sign a registration form and a student release form. Shortly thereafter, the class will go to the lake level of the building, where all the classes will take place.

**Class Schedule:** Six selected students will meet with the instructor for 12-14 consecutive Saturdays, from 12 to 4 PM. Because of the team-oriented nature of the program, all participating artist must attend every class for the duration of the program.

**Art Materials:** The instructor will provide all the art supplies needed for the project. Students may, at their discretion, choose to bring their own tools.

**Class Meeting Place:** The Muralism Program will be conducted in the lake level of the Bath House Cultural Center. This location offers, to a degree, an outdoor experience with limited air conditioning and heating, so students are encouraged to dress accordingly. To engage the community with the program, the studio space is open to the public. Students must be aware that, occasionally, art patrons and park visitors will have access to the painting area and that some of them will interact with the class.

**Parking:** Please park your vehicles on the parking lot that faces the front of the building. Park and Recreation rules prohibit parking vehicles on the grass and unpaved ground behind the Bath House. Parking briefly on the area behind the building to make quick deliveries or to unload materials must be approved by the Bath House Cultural Center staff.

**Food and drinks:** Food and drinks are allowed in the studio space. A refrigerator and a microwave oven are available for the students in the upper level of the building. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited. Restrooms are also available in the upper level.

**Program Goals:** The Muralism Program was created with the goal of fostering the growth of local visual artists who are interested in learning traditional and modern techniques of the art of mural-size painting. In addition to the benefits gained by the participating students, the Muralism Program will also provide opportunities for community involvement, educational development, and enhancement and beautification of the Bath House Cultural Center.

**The Instructor:** The Muralism Program will be conducted by Dallas visual artist, **Genaro Hernandez**. Mr. Hernandez has extensive experience working in both solo and group muralism art projects. For years, the instructor has collaborated in the creation of mural projects for cultural centers, hospitals, schools, and other sites in the DFW area.
